

# Management goals for the Green River State Forest

**Timber management** - produce high quality timber

- 1) thinning
- 2) harvests
- 3) timber stand improvement
- 4) enrichment plantings

**Demonstration / Research**

- 1) revert bottoms farmland to hardwood forest
- 2) restore cypress in slough area
- 3) incorporate high quality species in degraded areas

**Recreation** - Provide quality recreation for public

- 1) hunting : deer, duck, turkey, upland game
- 2) horse and bike riding
- 3) hiking
- 4) camping

**Wildlife Management** - Benefit many species

- 1) highly diverse landscapes
- 2) planting under power lines and wildlife openings
- 3) predator perches
- 4) future bluebird houses
